## Official Opening of the Lychgate

As you will have read over the last few newsletters the Parish Council has been involved in a project formally called the Kirkby Fleetham and Fencotes Commemorative Garden Space Project. This project was primarily to fund the building of the new lychgate at the Parish Cemetery at Great Fencote, but it also formed a wider heritage project which has involved many people within our community. Much of this project was funded by the National Heritage Lottery Fund.

The project over the last year has involved members of our community across the generations. Our school children have gained knowledge from experts in their field and learned about topics ranging from nature and wildlife to historical facts relating to their school and our local community. The community has had access to a heritage



consultant to give guidance and enthusiasm to benefit further research into the history of our forebears. All this knowledge has help to produce two very well received exhibitions, one in the village hall and another at the School's Heritage Day.

The legacy this has left is a knowledgeable community, confident in further delivery of oral history and research for an area which we can be proud to call home.



On 10<sup>th</sup> November at 2pm you are invited to join us to mark the completion of this project with the official opening of the lychgate. The commemoration of the day will also focus on the memorial plaque for the 14 fallen soldiers from the Great War. This plaque used to be in the porch of St Andrew's Church and is now mounted within the lychgate. Appropriately as it is Remembrance Sunday, wreaths will be laid within the lychgate and there will be an opportunity for all to reflect on a beautiful, peaceful place which has been recreated for the community to enjoy and to remember loved ones. The occasion will be followed by refreshments in the Village Hall.

"William Aislabie & the Designed Landscape of Kirkby Hall, Kirkby Fleetham"



Kirkby Hall was William Aislabie's marital home from 1724. William, politician and gentleman landscape designer, developed the property from the 1740s onwards, following the death of his father John, who had designed the water gardens at Studley Royal in the early 18<sup>th</sup> century.

Gail researched Kirkby Hall as a member of the Yorkshire Gardens
Trust Research & Recording Group in 2018/19.

Formerly County Archaeologist for North Yorkshire, she has worked part-time at the North Yorkshire County Record Office for the past six years and has a particular interest in 18th-century designed landscapes.


